

Chattahoochee Tri Club Rules of Conduct

1. Be courteous to all members and always display good sportsman-like conduct.
2. Do not cause physical harm or threaten physical harm to other members of the club. This includes forms of intimidation both publicly or cyber bullying of other members. If you believe a member is threatening you, bring this to the attention of a board member immediately.
3. Remember you are representing the club when you wear CTC apparel (t-shirts, hoodies, visors, tri kits). Behave in a manner that is beneficial to the club. This includes at races or events, or when on your own outside the group. When you wear the CTC logo, you are acting as a CTC Brand Ambassador. Any member who represents the club in a demeaning manner that results in the club being removed from events/venues or no longer welcome at events/venues, loss of sponsorship, or paying fees for intentionally damaging property will be expelled from the club for the remainder of the year.
4. If you have a discount code, please email it to the club at chattahoocheetriclub@gmail.com. We only want relevant codes of services and goods that apply to our members and keep all items pinned in a file accessible by all members at any time in our Facebook group. This helps keep the group page from becoming cluttered with posts and makes it easier for members to find discount codes.
5. Respect other people's privacy. Don't discuss or post personal information about other people, members or nonmembers, or try to phish for information about others in the private Facebook group or when around others in public. If a person does not want information public, that is their right and it should be respected.
6. Don't bring your outside problems into the club. If you have a conflict with another member, business, or sponsor who is part of the club, do not use the club or Facebook group as a forum to bash them. We expect our members to maintain civil behaviors towards one another when at club functions or in the club discussion group.
7. Watch your sense of humor. We have members from a variety of backgrounds and ages. We do not need to keep things G rated at all times, but at the same time, if it is of a graphic nature, please be cautious about who you joke around with.
8. Do not shame or chastise any members if they do something wrong. We make mistakes, ask an embarrassing question, whether as new-to-tri learning experiences or veterans-of-tri who just forgot. Instead, use the opportunity to enlighten and encourage members as they learn and grow, or provide an opportunity to refresh and share knowledge.
